Thank you for the ongoing opportunity to review and comment on the Draft City of Sacramento 2030 General Plan through the Inter-Agency Technical Advisory Committee. Our comments are as follows:


- Thank you for the response from the City Department of Transportation to our March 3, 2008 comment letter. The City's response detailed which comments were incorporated into the General Plan update, and provided an explanation as to why other comments were not incorporated.
- It is noted that the City addressed Corridor System Management Plans (CSMPs) within Policy M 1.3.5 and Policy M 1.3.6.
- Caltrans reiterates that the planned bus/carpool lane system on the State Highway System should be shown on Figure M2 "Street Classification" and Figure M3 "Street Classification: Core Area" in part because the bus/carpool lane system can help the City achieve the Goals and Policies set forth in the Mobility Element to achieve an integrated, multi-modal transportation system. It is understood that the City chose not to do so because the "figure is to classify city streets and identify the widths of these streets based on several factors including land use, transportation type, etc."
